Sunny Adeda's entry into the 70s marks the celebration of a hard-working veteran who has paid his dues in the corporate realm. With a stellar career spanning over three decades in the insurance industry, he built an exceptional track record defined by technical depth, commercial acumen, and strategic vision.

His journey began in October 1980, when he joined NICON Insurance as a graduate trainee. Over the years, he steadily rose through the ranks, acquiring deep expertise across risk management, policy evaluation, underwriting, and brokerage operations.

His competence propelled him to various senior management roles, culminating in his appointment as Executive Director (Technical) from October 1999 to July 2006, during which he helped position the organisation into one of Nigeria's premier risk management institutions.

Today, Adeda serves as the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Alpha Choice Insurance Brokers Limited, continuing to demonstrate exemplary leadership and mentorship across various sectors, including Life Assurance, Aviation, Oil and Gas, and the public sector.
